“Beekeeping 360” with Dr. Medhat Nasr

This is an opportunity for Maine beekeepers to learn from one of the great masters of northern climate apiary management!

Medhat Nasr is an expert in honey bee health and in articulating management strategies that maximize outcomes for both bee colonies and beekeepers. He has over 45 years of experience with beekeeping at all scales, and has the skills and knowledge to translate winning strategies from one scale to another.

While serving as Alberta Provincial Apiculturist Dr. Nasr extended the program to include applied bee research and extension activities. He was also an Apiculture Extension Professor at Rutgers University in NJ. Currently his research is focused on developing new alternative miticides for Varroa control, managing miticides resistance, evaluation of integrated pest management programs, and selection and breeding quality queens.

Dr. Nasr graduated from Cairo University, Giza, Egypt with BS and MSc degrees in Entomology. He earned a PhD in Entomology from University of California, Davis. He was the keynote speaker at MSBA's 2010 Annual Meeting.
